

MetaMask Missions FAQ

General Campaign Structure

Q: What is MetaMask Missions?

A: MetaMask Missions is a 3-week campaign running from **July 21 to August 8, 2025**, where users complete weekly missions to earn sweepstakes entries for a chance to win token rewards.

Q: How do I participate?

A: Simply mint the Missions Pass NFT in [the MetaMask Missions Portal](#) to opt-in and receive 1 entry. Once minted, you'll unlock access to weekly missions. You can then complete missions to earn additional entries into that week's prize pool. The more missions you complete, the more chances you'll have to win prizes.

Q: Do I have to opt-in to participate in MetaMask Missions?

A: Yes - minting the NFT is required to opt-in and participate in the sweepstakes and counts as a single entry for each weekly sweepstake. You will not be entered into the sweepstakes if you make transactions without opting in by minting the NFT. You must perform the swaps or bridges using the MetaMask wallet address you used to mint the opt-in NFT.

Q: Is there a cost to participate?

A: The campaign is free to join, but minting the opt-in NFT requires paying gas fees as determined by the network only.

Q: What platforms can I use to participate?

A: You can use MetaMask Extension, Mobile App, or Portfolio (MetaMask Web). The actions must be completed through MetaMask's native Swap or Bridge features.

Q: Can I switch between platforms during the campaign?

A: Yes, you can start a mission on one platform (e.g. make a swap on MetaMask Mobile App to receive 1 entry) and complete a swap on another (e.g. MetaMask Extension) to receive another entry, as long as it's all done with the same MetaMask wallet address that was used to mint the entry/participation NFT.

Q: When do missions start and end each week?

A: Each of the 3 mission weeks begin on a Monday at 9:00 AM EST during the campaign. The exact end time for each week will be displayed in the corresponding "Week" tab for reference.

Participation and Eligibility

Q: When can I opt-in and start completing missions?

A: MetaMask Missions goes live on Monday, July 21st. That's when you can mint your Missions Pass NFT to opt-in and begin completing Missions.

Q: Do I need to use a MetaMask wallet?

A: Yes. Only swaps/bridges made on MetaMask using the MetaMask wallet that minted the opt-in NFT are eligible.

Q: Do swaps through Uniswap (or other dApps) via MetaMask count?

A: No. Only swaps and bridges using MetaMask's built-in Swap and Bridge features count. Using third-party dApps (even if accessed through MetaMask) will not earn entries.

Q: Where will official campaign rules be posted?

A: The link to the Official Rules can be found [here](#), and can also be found in the MetaMask Missions Portal.

Q: Will users be guided on how to complete each mission?

A: No. Users can refer to the Official Rules, this FAQ, or instruction cards on the back of each mission in the MetaMask Missions Portal for information on how to complete missions. If you have questions or need help, feel free to ask in our community channels (invites linked below):

Q: What if users mistakenly use other platforms like Rabby or Uniswap to perform Swaps or Bridges?

A: These actions will not be counted.

Q: Do I need to mint the NFT before completing missions?

A: Yes, you must mint the NFT first. Transactions made before minting won't count, and missions will only unlock after the NFT is minted.

Q: What does "bridging to or from" mean? Do I need to move tokens in a specific direction?

A: No specific direction is required. You can bridge the specified token either into or out of the designated network. For example, if the mission requires bridging \$COMP on Arbitrum, both moving \$COMP to Arbitrum or from Arbitrum will count, as long as the correct token and network are involved.

Q: What if I see low liquidity when trying to bridge a token?

A: Some tokens, like \$aUSDC, may show low liquidity when bridging between certain networks. If you're having trouble with a specific route (e.g., bridging \$COMP from Network A to Network B), try a different direction or network combination - e.g., bridging \$COMP from Arbitrum into \$ETH on Polygon. As long as the correct token and network are involved and the transaction uses MetaMask Bridge, it will count toward the mission.

Types of Missions

Q: What are the types of missions in MetaMask Missions?

A: There are two types of Missions:

- **Token Missions** - Swap or bridge specific tokens (e.g. \$ONDO, \$COMP) on a specific network in minimum amounts.
- **Network Missions** - Perform 10 swaps/bridges of any token on a specific network (e.g. Linea, Arbitrum).

Q: Are missions different each week?

A: Yes. New missions are released every week and must be completed by the time each respective week closes. They vary in both tokens and networks featured.

Progress and Tracking

Q: How long does it take for entry progress to show in the MetaMask Missions Portal?

A: Progress is expected to update and refresh frequently throughout the day.

Q: Will the MetaMask Missions Portal show how many entries I have?

A: Yes, and there's a maximum of 82 entries per week per user.

Q: How do entries work?

A: Each completed mission earns a set number of entries. Every weekly mission (consisting of bridging or swapping specific tokens or on specific networks) correctly executed on MetaMask Web, Extension, or Mobile will grant you additional entries into that week's sweepstake (see Table 1 below for mission information).

Table 1

Mission Type	Task	Entries
Token Specific (two per week)	Swap or bridge eligible tokens on, to, or from a specific network using required amount	1, 5, or 10 sweepstake entries (based on amount)
Network Specific (two per week)	Perform all 10 swap or bridge transactions on specified network	10 sweepstake entries

Please refer to the MetaMask Missions token and network instructions each week in the MetaMask Missions Portal to view the eligible tokens, required transaction amounts, and eligible networks for that week's missions. Transaction requirements vary by token (e.g., most tokens may require transacting 10, 50, or 100 tokens, while others such as \$WBTC and \$COMP may require transacting fractional tokens).

For token-specific missions (two per week), you can earn 1, 5, or 10 additional entries based on the amount of tokens swapped or bridged on MetaMask. Required amounts, eligible tokens, and eligible networks are determined weekly and are available in the token and network instructions in the MetaMask Missions Portal.

For network specific missions (two per week), you may earn 10 additional entries for that week's sweepstake by executing all 10 transactions (bridge or swap) on that specific network.

If you complete all four weekly missions within the five days of any given week, the 2x multiplier will be activated and your total number of entries earned that week will be doubled.

Rewards and Prizes

Q: How will prizes be distributed?

A: Prizes will automatically be distributed to the winning users' wallets. There will be no ask to connect your wallet to claim them. We will never ask you to share your Secret Recovery Phrase (SRP). Never enter your SRP on any website that requests it. Stay alert for scams claiming otherwise.

Q: Can users from the US receive rewards in USDC instead of EURE?

A: No - users cannot choose which reward they receive. Prizes awarded to users will be randomly selected based on the prizes associated with the week they win.

Q: Can I see a list of winners?

A: Yes. Each week, MetaMask will post a list of the first four characters of the winning wallets for that week on MetaMask's official [X \(Twitter\) account](#). If you'd like to receive the full list of winners after the campaign ends, you can submit the form linked in the Official Rules. The list will be emailed to you from hello@metamask.io once MetaMask Missions has concluded.

Q: What can I win?

A: Weekly rewards are distributed in tokens like \$aUSDC, \$EURE, \$WBTC, \$COMP, etc., based on the week's missions. The prize pool is dynamic – more participation means bigger rewards, up to \$5K per week.

Q: How are winners chosen?

A: Winners are randomly selected through an on-chain randomization process via smart contract. Winners are drawn at the end of each week and announced publicly via the MetaMask X (Twitter) account.
